

**Declaration to the EU regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006** of the European Parliament and the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the **Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of chemicals (REACH)** published on the 30<sup>th</sup> of December 2006 in the EC-Official Journal 396/1.

IDS Imaging Development Systems GmbH is the manufacturer of products within the meanings of REACH and is classed as a "downstream operator". Therefore in principle, IDS Imaging Development Systems GmbH comes under no registration requirements according to REACH directive (EG)1907/2006.

And as a consequence, the events that you are inquiring about do not require registration within the meanings of REACH, according to the current state of our knowledge. This is especially true because no chemical materials can be released from our products under standard or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use (see Sect. 7 Para. 1 of the REACH-Regulation). Accordingly, any chemical materials in our products that might possibly require registration must only be registered by our suppliers.

In the interest of increased product safety, we stringently comply with REACH and its resulting requirements. By being in close contact with our suppliers, we ensure that we remain in compliance with the duty to inform under Sect. 33.

We constantly seek information as to whether the listed materials that require special care are contained at more than 0.1% by volume in the materials, preparations, or products we use. If we were to receive such information from our suppliers, we would comply with our duty to pass this information directly on to you or to our other clients.

There is no indication at the moment that our articles contain substances of very high concern exceeding the limit value. If and to the extent that SVHC should be contained in our articles, we will meet our obligations in accordance with REACH, including the obligation to provide information to our customers. This also applies for future changes in the candidate list.

Please understand that, given the large number of enquiries we receive, we are not able to respond to every inquiry individually.
