

Privacy Notice Regarding the Collection of Personal Data According to Articles 13, 14, and 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for Video Surveillance

With this notice, we inform you about the processing of your personal data and your rights under data protection law.

2. Purpose and Legal Basis of Data Processing

The processing is carried out within the framework of a balancing of interests pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The company processes personal data for the purposes of preventing vandalism, securing evidence/proving criminal offenses, detecting unauthorized access, enforcing property rights, asserting civil claims, and protecting its employees, customers, and other visitors. Our legitimate interests pursued include protection against criminal acts and their investigation or clarification. Furthermore, we aim to protect individuals on our premises and our property. In the event of a criminal offense, our legitimate interest lies in securing evidence.

3. Which categories of data do we use and where do they come from?

The company stores, within the coverage area of the installed cameras on the premises, among other things, the image of individuals who enter and remain on the premises, as well as other identifying features such as clothing and belongings carried by the individuals. The data is collected directly from the individual.

4. To whom is the data disclosed (categories of recipients)

Within our company, only those individuals and departments that require your personal data to fulfill their assigned tasks will receive access to it. The company processes the aforementioned personal data itself and transmits it, among others, to public authorities such as the police if the recording concerns a criminal offense. Otherwise, data is only transmitted to public authorities upon request and within the scope of the legal powers of the requesting authority. The transmission of data is carried out in compliance with data protection regulations.



5. Further information

Duration of data storage

The data is stored on a secured server. It is retained there for a maximum duration of 48 hours on working days and 72 hours on weekends or public holidays, unless legitimate interests require longer storage. In such cases, only the data necessary for these interests will be retained.

Data Transfer to Third Countries

No data is transferred to a third country.

Data Subject Rights

You may request information about the data stored about you using the contact details provided above (Art. 15 GDPR). Additionally, under certain conditions, you may request the correction or deletion of your data (Art. 16 and 17 GDPR). You have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data (Art. 18 GDPR). Furthermore, you have the right to receive the data you have provided in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format (Art. 20 GDPR). No automated decision-making or profiling takes place.

Obligation to Provide Data?

The provision of personal data is neither legally nor contractually required by the company. Failure to provide the data has no consequences. However, entering areas under video surveillance will result in the processing of your data.

Right to Lodge a Complaint

You have the option to file a complaint with the data protection officer named above or with a data protection supervisory authority.

Right to Object

If we process your data to safeguard legitimate interests, you may object to this processing if there are reasons arising from your particular situation that speak against the data processing. In such cases, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing that override your interests, rights, and freedoms, or the processing serves the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims.
